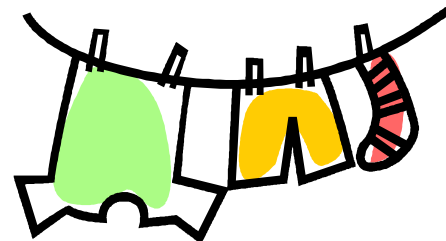


Washing Line



This activity can be used for either learning a new process or reviewing some learning at the end of an activity.

Materials required: washing line and some brightly coloured pegs, laminated cards with the learning on, A4 or larger size.

Learning a process

To use this activity in learning a process, begin with the laminated A4 cards; hand them out and ask the delegates if they can place them in the correct order. Chances are that they will get most of, if not all of them right.

Position the washing line with pegs attached in a suitable place in the room, where everyone will be able to see what has been pegged onto it.

If any of them are incorrect – praise them for the ones they got right and move the ones they got wrong, explaining briefly what the process is about and why it is in this order.

To review the learning, challenge the group to come up and put the laminates in the correct order having shuffled them about, you may wish to offer a small prize or even a sticker – they are amazing motivators even for adults!

A review activity

To use this just as a review activity – the laminated cards will contain pieces of information or bullet points. Get the delegates to pick a card and if they get the description correct, they can peg it on the washing line. To add some competition in a review, you could split the group into two teams and compete for correct answers.
